THEATRE STUDIES -THEATRE EDUCATION CONCENTRATION, WITH TEACHER CERTIFICATION IN THEATRE (PRESCHOOL-GRADE 12) (B.A.)

Students who wish to pursue P-12 teacher certification in Theatre must apply to and be admitted to the Teacher Education Program. Once admitted, students will be matriculated into the B.A. in Secondary Education (http://catalog.montclair.edu/programs/secondary-educationp12-ba/) program as a second major.
