

THEATRE STUDIES - THEATRE EDUCATION CONCENTRATION, WITH TEACHER CERTIFICATION IN THEATRE (PRESCHOOL- GRADE 12) (B.A.)

Students who wish to pursue P-12 teacher certification in Theatre must apply to and be admitted to the Teacher Education Program. Once admitted, students will be matriculated into the B.A. in Secondary Education (<http://catalog.montclair.edu/programs/secondary-education-p12-ba/>) program as a second major.

Students also are strongly advised to review the Teacher Education Program Handbook.

Unless otherwise noted, 120 credits of coursework is required for a baccalaureate degree with a minimum 2.0 overall GPA, and a minimum 2.0 major GPA.
