# VISUAL ARTS - ART EDUCATION CONCENTRATION WITH TEACHER CERTIFICATION IN ART (PRESCHOOL-GRADE 12) (B.A.) 

The Art Education Concentration is a professional degree option within the university's teacher preparation program that leads to qualification for the initial instructional certificate to teach P-12 art in New Jersey's (as well as our nation's) schools. Art Education students will participate in a combination of professional education courses and field experiences, basic studio and art history courses, and P-12 art classroom methods courses. The degree is appropriate for students who wish to teach art in various settings including museums and community centers, in addition to public and private schools for grades $\mathrm{P}-12$.

Students who wish to pursue P-12 teacher certification in Art must apply to and be admitted to the Teacher Education Program. Information regarding the required professional sequence of courses and other important Program requirements, guidelines, and procedures may be found on the Teacher Education Program website (https:// www.montclair.edu/center-of-pedagogy/). Students also are strongly advised to review the Teacher Education Program Handbook.

120 credits of coursework is required for the baccalaureate degree with a minimum 3.0 overall GPA. Major GPA requirements differ depending on field of study. Consult the Teacher Education Handbook for more information.
